

**WISCONSIN *Olympic Development Program Soccer* IS COMING TO LACROSSE,
WISCONSIN FOR 1997, 1998, AND 1999 BIRTH YEAR BOYS AND GIRLS!**

Wisconsin Olympic Development is a national identification and development program for high-level players looking to play soccer in high school and beyond. The program identifies and develops youth players throughout the country to represent their state association, region and the United States in soccer competition.

ODP teams are formed at the state association and regional levels, made up of the best players in various age groups. At the state association level, pools of players are identified in each eligible age group, and brought together as a team to develop their skill through training and competition. From the state pools and subsequent teams, players are identified for regional and national pools and teams.

What are the Goals of ODP?

- To identify a pool of players in each age group from which a United States National Team will be selected for international competition.
- To provide high-level training to benefit and enhance the development of players at all levels.
- Through the use of carefully selected licensed coaches, develop a mechanism for the enhancement of ideas and curriculum to improve all levels of coaching.

Wisconsin's Olympic Development Program is a group training that concentrates on improving individual skills and on individual player identification. It is geared toward players that may wish to compete past the high school level, but offers trainings beginning with boys and girls in the 1997, 1998, and 1999 birth years.

Boys and Girls ODP Developmental Registration is now available for the Wisconsin Olympic Development Program 2009-2010 season in LaCrosse, Wisconsin. Those sessions, being held in December and January cost \$135.00 for a series of four 2 hour sessions.
