The Women's Premier League (WPL) offers the highest level of amateur soccer in Wisconsin for women age 16 and older. The WPL features NCAA athletes, including former All Americans, playing competitive soccer against other college athletes from all regions of Wisconsin. The Ray Schommer Cup is the WPL's annual tournament. The Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association encourages U18, U19 and U23 teams to enter this cup. In the Ray Schommer Cup each team is guaranteed three matches. The four top teams will advance to the finals on Sunday the 19th.

Tournament Entry Fee:

\$200 registration fee and a \$200 participation bond per team are due on July 1, 2009

Saturday, July 18th

Each match will be 60 minutes with a five-minute half time. Two games from Group play guaranteed on Saturday. Game times will be determined 1 week prior to the cup.

Sunday, July 19th Group Play and Championship

The third game from group play will be held on Sunday morning. All matches will be 60 minutes with a five-minute half time. The Championship and Third Place matches will be 60 minutes with a ten-minute half time, no overtime, directly to penalty kicks if needed to determine a winner. No referee fees for Sunday afternoon games.

Eligibility:

Any team participating in the WPL, Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association affiliation, is eligible to play. All participating teams from out-of-state MUST be fully registered with their state association. Teams may carry a full roster of 24 maximum players for the tournament. All players must be registered with their respected association and have a valid player pass. Guest players are permitted.

Registration:

All teams must have a coach/manager check the team in at the tent prior to the start of the first match. The following items must be presented at the time of registration:



2 typed rosters with the names and registration numbers from the player passes.

24 Player Passes

5 Game / Referee Report Forms

Team Rules:

The team listed first on the schedule will be the home team. The home team will wear light colored jerseys and will start the match with the kickoff, the visiting team taking the kickoff to start the second half. The home team must furnish three (3) balls to the official to be used for the game balls. Both participating teams must sit on the same sideline with the spectators on the opposite sideline.

Substitution(s):

Substitution is unlimited. All substitutes must enter from the half field line when acknowledged by the line person and the official. Both teams may substitute on a throw-in, as long as the team in possession of the throw-in is substituting a player, on an injury or on their own corner kick.

Game Format:

All participating teams will participate in a round robin balanced format with a three-match guarantee to qualify for the championship. The top two teams will advance to the final match on Sunday. All group play matches will be 2 x 30-minute halves with a 5-minute half. Sunday's finals will be 60-minutes with a 10-minute half time, no overtime, directly to penalty kicks if needed to determine a tournament champion.

Scoring:

Win – 3 points Ties – 1 points Loss – 0 points

Goals – 1 point per goal with a maximum of three (3) points to be awarded.

Shutout – 1 point (0-0 ties will not be awarded points)

Tie Breakers:

- 1) Head to Head competition
- 2) Goal Differential (Goals scored – goals allowed)
- 3) Goals scored
- 4) Goals allowed

Awards:

There will be a trophy for the first and second place teams.
