Northwest Classic League



WYSA is providing a Classic league in the Northwest district starting Fall 2021. This league will be facilitated by WYSA to provide a competitive league environment in the Northwest district. Along with additional programming we are confident this league will help serve the growth of soccer in the area.

Participating in this league will not only provide a structured league option, but will also provide new avenues for competition, such as WYSA's State League, Wisconsin State Championship, Presidents Cup, and Cross-Over District competitions.

League Structure



- **League Window:** September 11th through November 1st.
- **Games:** 6-8 games, round robin, home and away.
- **Placement:** WYSA places teams into appropriate divisions.
- **Scheduling:** Game dates schedules are generated based off team blackout dates, and then distributed. Games will be scheduled on Saturdays and Sundays but will have the flexibility to be reschedule to weekdays during the reschedule window.
- **Club Schedule Window:** Clubs then schedule times & field location per home game.
- **Reschedule Window:** Clubs can request reschedules of dates, and times during this window.
- **Referee Assignor Window:** WYSA distributes schedules to the referee assignors.
- **Online Schedule Posted:** Schedules are now considered complete and will be posted on the Northwest Classic League page on the WYSA website.

Applications



- The Northwest Classic League application window is July 1st through August 2nd.
- WYSA will collect individual team applications and payments upon submission 10U \$150, 11-18U \$200.
- Teams will be allowed to Blackout 2 dates.
- What to expect on applications: Team & Club Name, Age, Gender, Manager contact, Coach contact, Leadership Contact Blackout dates, and Payment.

Age & Gender



- Northwest Classic League will be for both boys and girls.
- Fall: Girls 10U-18U, Boys 10U-15U.
- Spring: Boys 10U-18U, Girls 10U-15U.
- Players will need to be registered as competitive players through USYS. 10U teams register as recreational.
- Ages 10U through 18U depending on participation.
- Club Pass Players: Any player in the club that is of eligible age can be club passed to that team.

Game Day Responsibilities



- Each team will provide the referees an official state WYSA roster.
- Official uniforms with corresponding #'s on the back.
- The referee fees are split in half between the home and away team.

Referees & Assigning



- Games will need to be assigned licensed referees by a licensed referee assignor.
- The referee pay scale will be determined by WYSA.
- Each team will be responsible for half of the referee fees per match.
- If your club does not have a licensed assignor, WYSA will work with you to facilitate one.

Standings



- Every Northwest Classic League game will have a unique game #.
- Teams are responsible for reporting games scores after every match.
- Team managers will be provided a “League Code” prior to league start.
- AWARD: League winners received a WYSA league champion t-shirt.

League Benefits



- Teams participating in the Northwest Classic League will be recognized as participating in a WYSA league.
- Teams will have options to participate/qualify for the WYSA State League, Wisconsin State Championships, and District competitions.
- WYSA handles application, team placements, division set up, and scheduling.
- WYSA provide the Northwest Classic League its own space on our website.
- WYSA provides our partnered software service Demoshpere.
- League standings displayed on the WYSA website.
