WYSA Return to Play Follow Up | August 20, 2020

Return to Play Checklist

As a reminder, clubs must meet the criteria in the [WYSA Return to Play Checklist & Requirements](#) and are required to submit an electronic acknowledgement prior to engaging in soccer activities, regardless of the phase they are in.

Enforcement Responsibility

It is the responsibility of each member club to both communicate and ensure their members are compliant with requirements set forth in the RTP Checklist. Referees will not be enforcing compliance at games nor is it the responsibility of the home club to enforce compliance from visiting teams.

Unsanctioned Activities

Effective August 20, teams who participate in unsanctioned play are restricted from participation in WYSA sanctioned activities for 14 days following the date of participation. This includes participation in unsanctioned tournaments, friendlies or other competitions not approved by WYSA. Teams who are restricted from participation will be required to reschedule league games under the approval of their respective Competition's Director.

Fall 2020 Cups

The Fall 2020 President and State Cup events will proceed on the originally scheduled dates using multiple venues, with strict guidelines for participation. The application deadline is August 24. Additional event details will be distributed by the Competitions Department this week.

High School Boys Leagues

WIAA's decision on interscholastic athletics will impact fall and spring high school aged boys teams. Next week clubs will receive information about a fall league offering from WYSA. We will continue to gather information and consider possible adjustments to spring programs with details to be announced at a later date.
