Policy 531-9 Ref Abuse & Prevention

- USSF Policy so it applies to any match played under their sanctioning, except professional games. Includes (league games, tournaments, cups, etc).
- The updated policy includes stronger sanctions for any form of physical or nonphysical abuse towards referees. We encourage every player and coach to learn what behaviors cross the line, so they can avoid penalties and help create a better culture for the future of soccer.
- Policy shall supersede any inconsistent rules of Member Organizations (US Soccer) that pertain to assault, abuse, or gross mistreatment upon Federation Game

Policy 531-9 Ref Abuse & Prevention

- Single offenses are at minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty for non red zone offenses
- Second time offenders receive double punishment
- Third time offenders receive a lifetime ban
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment
